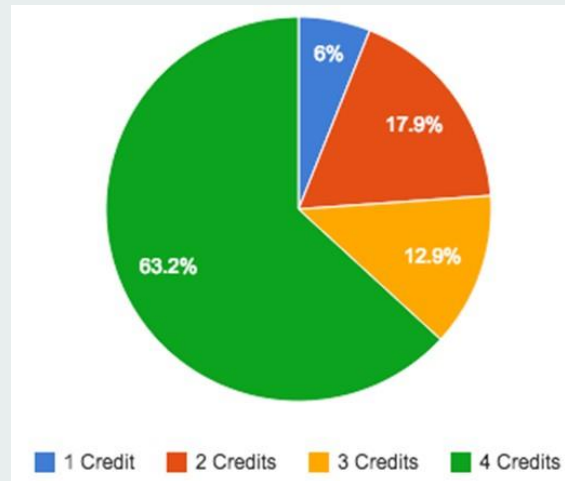
Вам следует пройти тестирование STAMP, если вы:

How are credits earned?

- You can earn up to 4 Applied Arts elective credits (AR) that will appear on your NCSD high school transcript.

Benchmark 9 = 4 credits

Benchmark 8 = 4 credits

Benchmark 7 = 4 credits

Benchmark 6 = 4 credits

Benchmark 5 = 3 credits

Benchmark 4 = 2 credits

Benchmark 3 = 1 credits

Benchmark 2 = 0 credits

Benchmark 1 = 0 credits

- Your assessments results will be delivered to you approximately one month after the assessment date.

How much does the assessment cost?

- At this time, the STAMP assessment is free to NCSD 9-12 grade students currently enrolled in a NCSD high school.
- There is no limit to the number of languages or times you can attempt each assessment.
- 13 World Languages are offered through the STAMP assessment. Portuguese, Hindi, Polish, Spanish, Russian, Korean, Arabic, French, Italian, German, Hebrew, Mandarin, Japanese.
