Clackamas Middle College (CMC) Families,

As we implement Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL) this fall, our conferences will look a little different this year. CMC will host its annual Parent/Guardian-Teacher Conferences <u>virtually</u> for two days instead of one to give families more of an opportunity to meet with their child and teachers. This year, our Parent/Guardian-Teacher Conferences will be on Monday, November 23rd, and Tuesday, November 24th.

These virtual conference dates are for families of students in all of CMC's programs. We will have CMC counselors, teachers, and other staff members available to answer any questions you might have. On **Day 1-Monday, November 23rd**, we are focusing on families with students who are receiving C's or lower in their classes. This will give us the opportunity to help students who are receiving lower grades in order to give the adequate support and guidance to improve these grades for the fall trimester. The conference times for **Day 1-Monday, November 23rd** begin at 12:00pm and run through 7:30pm in the evening with a smaller break, and dinner break built into the schedule. *If your child has a C or lower in most classes, please go to the following link to schedule the best time to meet with your child's instructors on Day 1-Monday, November 23rd from 12pm-7:30pm.*
