
What is the STAMP Assessment?

- The STAMP (Standards-Based Measurement of Proficiency) is a computer-based assessment that measures your level of proficiency in reading, writing, speaking and listening.
- The STAMP is aligned to state and national benchmarks for World Languages and takes approximately 3 hours to complete.
- STAMP is recognized by Oregon Universities and fulfills admission requirements for World Language if the student demonstrates reading, writing, speaking, and listening at a Benchmark 3 or above.

When is the assessment offered?

- To register, contact your school counselor for more information on specific dates, times, locations and languages.
- Generally, the STAMP is offered twice a year; once in the fall and once in the spring.

Do you speak a language other than English?

North Clackamas high school students, who speak a language other than English, or who have acquired a World Language, can earn high school elective credits when they take the STAMP assessment.

- Need elective credits for graduation
- Want to have more elective class options
- Want to demonstrate proficiency in a World Language
- Want to fulfill the university admission requirements for a World Language
- Are interested in earning the Oregon Department of Education's State Seal of Biliteracy at graduation



How are credits earned?

 You can earn up to 4 Applied Arts elective credits (AR) that will appear on your NCSD high school transcript.

Benchmark 9 = 4 credits
Benchmark 8 = 4 credits
Benchmark 7 = 4 credits
Benchmark 6 = 4 credits
Benchmark 5 = 3 credits
Benchmark 4 = 2 credits
Benchmark 3 = 1 credits
Benchmark 2 = 0 credits
Benchmark 1 = 0 credits

 Your assessments results will be delivered to you approximately one month after the assessment date.

How much does the assessment cost?

- At this time, the STAMP assessment is free to NCSD 9-12 grade students currently enrolled in a NCSD high school.
- There is no limit to the number of languages or times you can attempt each assessment.
- 13 World Languages are offered through the STAMP assessment. Portuguese, Hindi, Polish, Spanish, Russian, Korean, Arabic, French, Italian, German, Hebrew, Mandarin, Japanese.
